



2011 Craft Fair Volunteer Opportunities

Parents: Listed below are the types of positions you can sign up for when the Craft Fair staffing boards are available in the office on Monday, Oct. 3. Online sign-ups will also be available this year.

****Popular shifts fill up fast, so be sure to sign up for your preferred job and shift as soon as possible.****

SET UP: Help to transport crafter materials, and Craft Fair/Carnival equipment on Friday or Saturday mornings. (Dads, we really appreciate your help before work here!) Guess what...you're first to see the goods!

CARNIVAL TICKETS: Sell tickets for the carnival games on Saturday. See your friends!

CASHIER/CHECKOUT: Calculate totals for shopper purchases, collect cash, check and credit card payments, and bag merchandise for customers. It's a great chance to see everything for sale!

BAKE SALE: Package and/or sell baked goods that preschool families donate. YUMMY job!

OPPORTUNITY DRAWING: Sell tickets for prizes that are drawn at the end of the fair. You get to help make someone a WINNER!

GREETERS: Greet shoppers at the front door of the fair, hand out boxes and explain payment options. Assist shoppers as needed and place items on hold for shoppers who are still shopping.

DATA ENTRY: Must be comfortable with using a computer and data entry in Excel. A brief training session will be held prior to each shift.

FLOATER: Help support any position that is extra busy. Fill in for unfilled positions. You have a chance to try your hand at many different jobs!

FLOWER MART: Sell flowers at the new Craft Fair Flower Mart.

CLEAN UP: Help put away tables, chairs, and equipment associated with the Craft Fair and Carnival on Saturday afternoon. (Dads, we really appreciate your help here too!) Oh...another successful year to wrap up!

Sign up boards will be available in the preschool office starting Monday, Oct. 3 and at the preschool gate on Monday, Oct. 10. Online shift sign-ups will also be available the week of Oct. 3.

Special Note Regarding Saturday Shift: The Saturday shifts can be harder to fill because many of us are so busy with weekend commitments. If you can volunteer for a shift that day, we really appreciate it. Remember, if you bring your whole family, one parent can volunteer while the other enjoys the carnival with the children.
